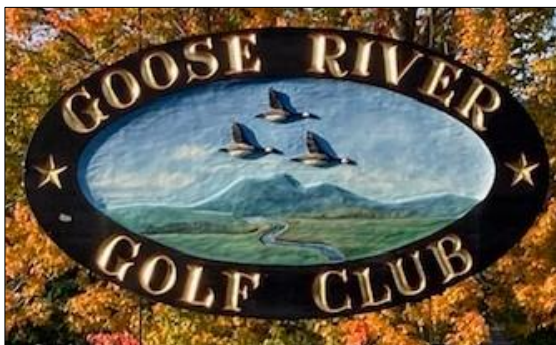

II. Hours of Operation

The clubhouse and golf course are open every day during the season, weather permitting. Public closure announcements will be made via Facebook.

April 1 - April 15
10:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m.

April 15 - June 1
8:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m.

June 1 - September 1
7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

September 1 - November 1
8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

November 1 - November 15
10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Driving Range

All driving range baskets may be purchased in the clubhouse.

April 15 - October 15
Tuesday - Sunday
8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Last bucket will be sold at 5:45 p.m.
Driving range is closed every Monday for lawn maintenance.



III. Member and Guest Policies

A. Pace of Play Policy

- 9-hole rounds should not exceed 2 hours.
- 18-hole rounds should not exceed 4 hours.
- Faster groups should be allowed to play through.
- Single players will not be permitted to play unless the number of players on the course and/or subsequent tee times are low enough to accommodate a single.

B. Alcohol Policy

Goose River staff reserves the right to stop serving alcohol to any member or guest at our discretion.

No alcohol is allowed on the course except that which is purchased in the clubhouse. Persons who bring outside alcohol onto the course will be asked to leave.

C. Credit Policy

All club credit must be used by the final day of the golf season.

Credit arrangements must be cleared with Head Golf Professional Alex Plummer. No other staff member is authorized to conduct credit arrangements.

D. GHIN Policy

Goose River Golf Club strongly encourages all members to maintain a current GHIN membership. The cost for GHIN membership is \$40 and can be purchased in the Pro Shop.

Pro Shop staff is NOT responsible for individual entry of GHIN scoring. All members are required to post all applicable scores in a timely manner. Scores can be entered in the clubhouse or on your mobile device utilizing the GHIN mobile app.



III. Member and Guest Policies (cont.)

E. Course Conduct Policy

All members and guests shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner when on the golf course.

All golf carts must be driven properly, with respect to the golf course, fellow golfers, and in adherence with the marked cart ropes and signs that specify where a player can and cannot drive a cart on the golf course.

Inappropriate behavior, excessive profanity, or intentional damage to the golf course will not be tolerated, and may result in the loss of playing privileges, or possible revocation of membership.

All members and guests must wear appropriate golf attire while on the property. Shirts and shoes should always be worn in the clubhouse. Sleeveless shirts for men are not allowed on the property.

F. Dog Policy

Well behaved dogs are welcome at Goose River Golf Club, subject to these guidelines:

- All dogs must be on a leash within 100 yards of the clubhouse.
- All dogs on the golf course must be on a leash, or be responsive to basic verbal control.
- All dog owners who do not properly dispose of their dogs' waste are subject to forfeiting their respective pet privileges.
- All dogs must be registered with their respective towns, and be current with regard to all applicable vaccinations.
- Any dog that exhibits aggressive behavior or has an incident that causes issue with another member or guest will lose their right to be on course property.

VI. 2022 Tournament Schedule

All tournament entries must be accompanied with a USGA handicap index and active GHIN membership. There are no exceptions.

GHIN membership can be purchased in the Pro Shop for \$40.00.

- June 1: Two Ball, Gross and Net Championship
Brackets posted. Gross and net. All matches begin June 1. \$35.00 entry fee per person.
- June 4: The Haskell Horse Race
Open to all male players with a 15.0 handicap index or above. Gross. Shotgun start at 3:00 p.m. \$35.00 entry fee.
- June 8: First Sadie Hawkins
Open to all members. Teams consist of one women, and one man. Gross and net. Maximum 20 teams. \$50.00 per team.
- July 22, 23, 24: Goose River Invitational
Open to all members. Gross and net. 40-player maximum. \$300.00 entry fee per team.
- August 20: Men's Senior Club Championship
Open to all players 55 years of age and older. Gross and net. Tee times begin at 8:00 a.m. \$35.00 entry fee.

- August 21: Men's Super-Sr. Club Championship
Open to all players age 65 and above.
Gross and net. Tee times begin at 8:00 a.m.
\$35.00 entry fee.

- September 3: Ladies Club Championship
Open all to all ladies. Gross and net. Tee
times begin at 8:00 a.m. \$35.00 entry fee.

- September 14: Second Sadie Hawkins
Open to all members. Teams consist of one
women, and one man. Gross and net.
Maximum 20 teams. \$50.00 per team.

- September 17: Ladies Filly Race
Open to all ladies with handicap index 15.0
and higher. Gross. Shotgun start at 12:00
p.m. \$35.00 entry fee.

- September 24: Fall Ryder Cup
Open to all players. Gross and net.
Two-person teams. Maximum 20 teams.
Shotgun start at 10:00 a.m. \$100.00 entry
fee per team.

- October 9: Cross Country
Open to all players. Gross and net. Four-person
teams. 15 team maximum. Shotgun start at
11:00 a.m. \$100.00 entry fee per team.



VII. Leagues

A. Men's Twilight League

- 64 Players | 8 Flights | 14 Weeks
- Flights are based solely on handicap index
- Weekly matches are contested on both Bald Eagle and Blue Heron tees
- Match play format
- League begins Tuesday, May 24th
- Shotgun start at 4:00 p.m.
- No players allowed on course after 3:00 p.m. on Twilight night
- All interested players may sign up in clubhouse
- \$200.00 entry fee (includes GHIN fee)
- \$10.00 weekly entry fee for pins and skins
- Twilight Banquet will be held following conclusion of the season

B. Ladies Twilight League

- 14 weeks
- Flighted games played weekly on Blue Heron tees
- All flights are solely based on handicap
- Gross and net competition
- Shotgun start at 4:30 p.m.
- League begins Wednesday, May 25th
- All interested players may sign up in clubhouse
- \$90.00 entry fee (includes GHIN fee)
- \$6.00 weekly entry fee for pins and sweeps
- Ladies League banquet will be held following the conclusion of the season
